The Sankey Canal Milestone Project

12th January 2021

The installation of the Sankey Canal Milestones is almost complete, with only the "1 Mile to Widnes Lock" to go in when Halton Council upgrade their section of towpath.

The milestones are replicas of the original circa 1762 markers which were installed after the canal was extended to Fidlers Ferry in that year, hence the reason for the confusing change at Fiddlers Ferry to" Mile to Widnes Lock".


Locations of the new Milestones






